In SFBC&TS's AA in Biblical & Theological Studies, you will study the Bible in-depth, learn biblical interpretation techniques, develop useful research skills, and collaborate with other students.

This program is often used as a stepping stone to pursue a bachelor's degree in one of SFBC&TS's undergraduate programs such as Biblical & Theological Studies, Ministry & Leadership, Business Administration & Management, Christian Counseling, or Psychology.
